








































AI (ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE): AN AREA OF COMPUTER SCIENCE THAT DEALS WITH THE CREATION OF INTELLIGENT MACHINES THAT IMITATE INTELLIGENT HUMAN BEHAVIOUR SUCH AS LEARNING AND PROBLEM-SOLVING.

DISPLACEMENT: MOVEMENT OF PERSONS WHO HAVE BEEN FORCED OR OBLIGED TO FLEE OR TO LEAVE THEIR HOMES. IN PARTICULAR AS A RESULT OF OR IN ORDER TO AVOID THE EFFECTS OF ARMED CONFLICT, SITUATIONS OF GENERALI-ZED VIOLENCE, VIOLATIONS OF HUMAN RIGHTS OR NATURAL OR HUMAN-MADE DISASTERS. THE TERM IS USUALLY ASSOCIATED WITH "INTERNAL" DISPLACEMENT, MEANING THAT THE MOVEMENT HAPPENS WITHIN THE BORDERS OF A COUNTRY.

DRONE: AN UNMANNED AIRCRAFT GUIDED BY REMOTE CONTROL OR AUTONOMOUSLY BY ONBOARD COMPUTERS.



FORCED (OR COMPULSORY) LABOUR: WORK OR SERVICES INVOLUNTARILY UNDERTAKEN BY A PERSON UNDER THE THREAT OF PUNISHMENT. HOWEVER, THESE DO NOT INCLUDE MILITARY OR CIVIC SERVICE OBLIGATIONS OR LABOUR THAT IS A CONSEQUENCE OF A CONVICTION IN A COURT OF LAW.

HUMAN TRAFFICKING: THE RECRUITMENT, TRANSPORTATION, TRANSFER, HARBOURING OR RECEIPT OF PERSONS, BY MEANS OF THE THREAT OR USE OF FORCE OR OTHER FORMS OF COERCION, OF ABDUCTION, OF FRAUD, OF DECEPTION, OF THE ABUSE OF POWER OR OF A POSITION OF VULNERABILITY OR OF THE GIVING OR RECEIVING OF PAYMENTS OR BENEFITS TO ACHIEVE THE CONSENT OF A PERSON HAVING CONTROL OVER ANOTHER PERSON, FOR THE PURPOSE OF EXPLOITATION, EXPLOITATION INCLUDES, AT A MINIMUM, THE EXPLOITATION OF THE PROSTITUTION OF OTHERS OR OTHER FORMS OF SEXUAL EXPLOITATION, FORCED LABOUR OR SERVICES, SLAVERY OR PRACTICES SIMILAR TO SLAVERY. SERVITUDE OR THE REMOVAL OF ORGANS.

IRREGULAR MIGRATION: MOVEMENT OF PERSONS THAT TAKES PLACE OUTSIDE THE LAWS, REGULATIONS, OR INTERNA-TIONAL AGREEMENTS GOVERNING THE ENTRY INTO OR EXIT FROM THE ORIGIN, TRANSIT AND DESTINATION COUNTRIES.

ORGANIZED CRIMINAL GROUP: A STRUCTURED GROUP OF THREE OR MORE PERSONS THAT EXISTS FOR A PERIOD OF TIME AND ACTS IN CONCERT. THEIR AIM IS TO COMMIT ONE OR MORE SERIOUS CRIMES OR OFFENCES IN ORDER TO OBTAIN, DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY, FINANCIAL OR OTHER MATERIAL BENEFIT.

SMUGGLING OF MIGRANTS: A CRIME INVOLVING THE PROCUREMENT FOR FINANCIAL OR OTHER MATERIAL BENEFIT OF THE ILLEGAL ENTRY OF A PERSON INTO A COUNTRY OF WHICH THE PERSON IS NOT A NATIONAL OR A PERMANENT RESIDENT.





5.2 Eliminate all forms of violence against all women and girls in the public and private spheres, including trafficking and sexual and other types of exploitation



10.7 Facilitate orderly, safe, regular and responsible migration and mobility of people, including through the implementation of planned and well-managed migration policies
